

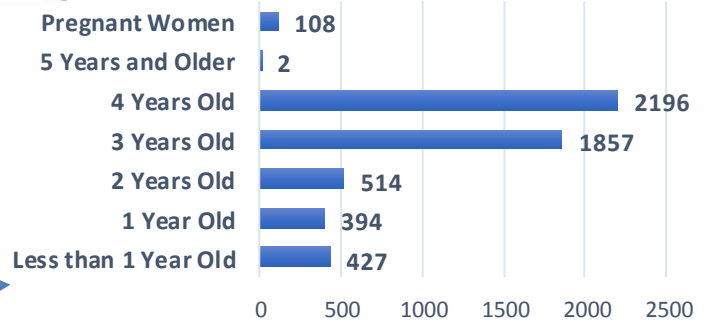
# Head Start and Early Head Start in South Dakota 2018

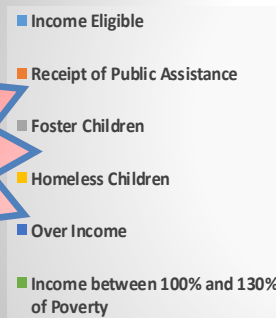

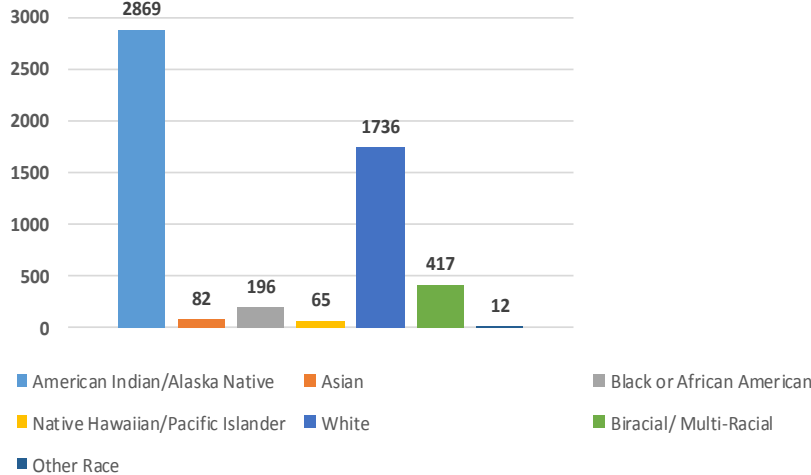


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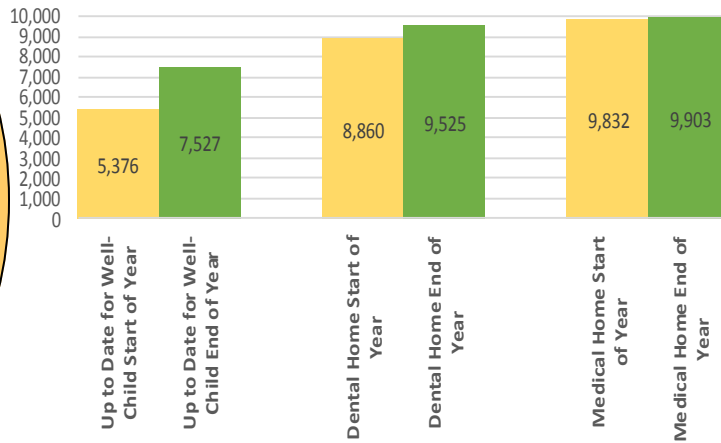
### Enrollment by Race - 2018

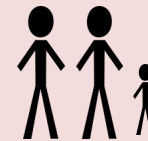
### Head Start Comprehensive Services - 2018

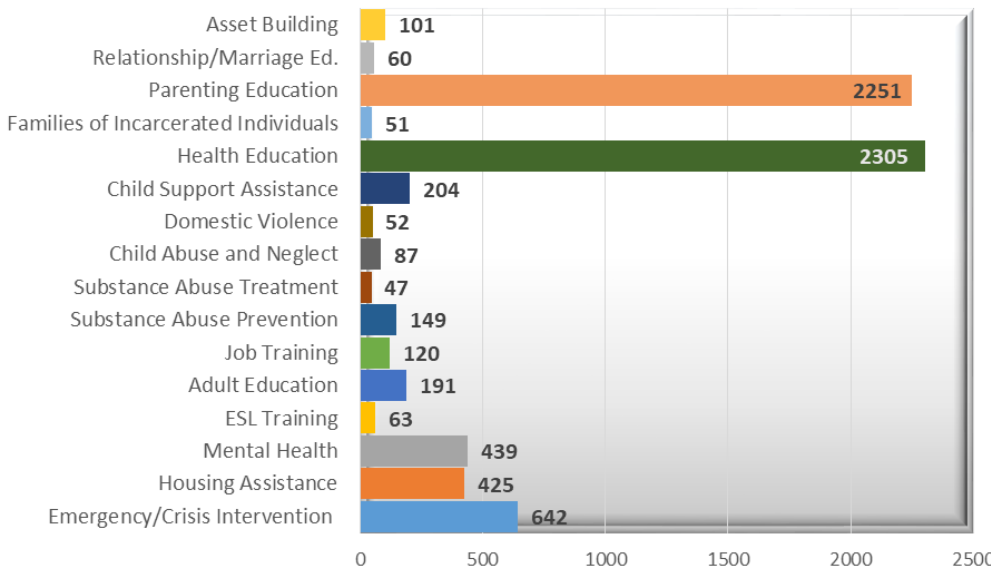
